## Installing the firmware update file

Download the ZIP file containing the firmware update file from F2/F2-BT download page.



## Extracting zip files and copying files to SD cards

#### For Windows

#### 1. Extracting the ZIP file.

Select the folder where you downloaded the ZIP file. ① Click "Compressed Folder Tools", then ② "Extract All". The ZIP file will be extracted.

### For Mac

#### 1. Opening the downloaded file.

After downloading, click "Downloads" displayed at the bottom of the screen. Then click 2 to open the downloaded file.



### 2. Copying the firmware update file to a SD card.

Copy the "F2SYSTEM.BIN" file to the root directory on a SD card.



### Update the firmware

The following is the same procedure for Windows and Mac.

#### 1. Insert the SD card into the F2/F2-BT.



#### NOTE

- Always make certain that the power is off when inserting or removing a SD card. Inserting or removing a card while the power is on could result in data loss.
- When inserting a SD card, be sure to insert the correct end with the top side up as shown.

### 2. Install new batteries in the F2/F2-BT or connect an AC adapter.

3. While pressing **>**, set



to ON.

#### 4. Confirm that the three indicators are lit orange, and press



This starts the firmware update.

#### NOTE

- During the firmware update, do not turn the power off or remove the SD card. Doing so could cause the F2/F2-BT to become unstartable.
- If one of the indicators continues blinking red and does not become orange, use the F2 Editor computer application to format the microSD card for use with the F2/F2-BT.
   F2 Editor can be downloaded from the ZOOM website (zoomcorp.com).
- In the unlikely event that a firmware update should fail, conduct the procedures from the beginning to update the firmware again.



When the update completes, one of the indicators will light green.



## Checking the firmware version

The firmware version can be checked using the F2 Editor computer application.
