## Installing the firmware update file

Download the ZIP file containing the firmware update file from F8 download page.



# Extracting zip files and copying files to SD cards

## ■ For Windows


### 1. Extracting the ZIP file.

Select the folder where you downloaded the ZIP file. ① Click "Compressed Folder Tools", then ② "Extract All". The ZIP file will be extracted.



### 2. Copying the firmware update file to a SD card.


Copy the "F8SYSTEM.BIN" file to the root directory on a SD card.



## ■ For Mac


### 1. Opening the downloaded file.

After downloading, click "Downloads" displayed at the bottom of the screen. Then click ② to open the downloaded file.



### 2. Copying the firmware update file to a SD card.


Copy the "F8SYSTEM.BIN" file to the root directory on a SD card.



# Update the firmware

The following is the same procedure for Windows and Mac.

## 1. Insert the SD card into the SD CARD 1 slot.




### NOTE

- Always make certain that the power is off when inserting or removing a SD card. Inserting or removing a card while the power is on could result in data loss.
- When inserting a SD card, be sure to insert the correct end with the top side up as shown.



## 2. Install new batteries in the F8 or connect the AC adapter.


## 3. Turn the power on while pressing .



### NOTE

- If the SD card is loaded in the SD CARD 2 slot, eject it before updating.


4. Use  to select “Yes” and press .



#### NOTE

- During the firmware update, do not turn the power off or remove the SD card. It could cause the F8 to be unstartable.
- In the unlikely event that a firmware update should fail, conduct the procedures from the beginning to update the firmware again.



5. After the update completes, turn the power off.




# Checking the firmware version

Check the Firmware Version.

1. Press .

2. Use  to select “SYSTEM” and press .



3. Use  to select “Firmware Version”, and press .

Check the Firmware Version displayed on the screen.
