1. Download the firmware update file.


Download the ZIP file that contains the firmware update file from the H3-VR download page.


On Windows

2. Extract the ZIP file.

Select the folder that contains the downloaded ZIP file. Click (1) "Compressed Folder Tools" followed by (2) "Extract all". This extracts the ZIP file.



3. Copy the firmware update file to a microSD card. Copy the "H3VRSYSTEM.BIN" file to a microSD card.





On macOS

2. Extract the file.


After downloading, open the (1) "Downloads" folder, which appears at the right end of the Dock by default. Then, click (2). Downloaded files will be shown.





3. Copy the firmware update file to a microSD card. Copy the "H3VRSYSTEM.BIN" file to a microSD card.





Firmware update file


Copy the firmware update file to a microSD card.


The following procedures are the same on both Windows and macOS.

Install new batteries in the H3-VR or connect an AC adapter.
<u>NOTE</u>

Executing a firmware update is not possible if the remaining battery power is low.

- **5.** Insert the microSD card into the H3-VR.
- **6.** While pressing (\mathbf{b}, \mathbf{b}) , turn the power on.







This starts the firmware update.

<u>NOTE</u>

During the firmware update, do not turn the power off or remove the microSD card. Doing so could cause the H3-VR to become unstartable.

8. After the firmware update completes, turn the power off.




<u>NOTE</u>

In the unlikely event that a firmware update should fail, conduct the procedures from the beginning to update the firmware again.

Checking the firmware versions

1. Press



This opens the Menu Screen.

2. Use (1+4) and (1+4) to select "System", and press (1+7).
