Firmware update process

- 1. Download the firmware update file.
- 2. Extract the ZIP file.
- 3. Copy the extracted firmware update file to a microSD card.
- 4. Update the firmware.
- 5. Confirm that the firmware has been updated correctly.



microSD card

Updating the Firmware

This guide explains firmware update to version 2.00 as an example.

1. Download the firmware update file.

Download the ZIP file that contains the firmware update file from the R12 download page.



On Windows

2. Extract the ZIP file.

Select the folder that contains the downloaded ZIP file. Click ① "Compressed Folder Tools" and then click ② "Extract all". This extracts the ZIP file.



3. Copy the firmware update file to a microSD card. Copy the "R12SYSTEM.BIN" file to a microSD card.



Firmware update file

Copy the firmware update file to a microSD card.

On macOS

2. Extract the ZIP file.

After downloading, open the (1) "Downloads" folder which appears at the right end of the Dock by default. Then, click (2). Downloaded files will be shown.



3. Copy the firmware update file to a microSD card. Copy the "R12SYSTEM.BIN" file to a microSD card.

Copy the firmware update file to a microSD card.

The following procedures are the same on both Windows and macOS.

4. Connect an AC adapter.

<u>NOTE</u>

Updating the firmware is not possible when operating with battery power.

5. Insert the microSD card into the R12.



6. Turn the power on.



7. TAP 🔯 on the Projects Screen.



HINT

If launched while a project is open, return to the Project Screen.

8. TAP "Firmware Update".



9. TAP "Execute".



10. Turn the power off when the following message is displayed.



11. Turn the power on again.



The PLAY indicator will blink and firmware updating will begin.



<u>NOTE</u>

During the firmware update, do not turn the power off or remove the microSD card. Doing so could cause the R12 to become unstart able.

12. After the firmware update completes, turn the power off.



<u>NOTE</u>

In the unlikely event that the screen is not shown and the REC indicator lights, turn the power off and on again once and conduct the firmware update again.



Confirming that the firmware has been updated correctly

Check the firmware versions used by the R12.

1. TAP 🔯 on the Projects Screen .



2. Tap "Firmwear Version".



3. Check the firmware version.
