

# Procedures for importing WAV files created in Logic Pro or Pro Tools to the MS-90LP+

WAV files created in Logic Pro or Pro Tools can be imported to a ZOOM MS-90LP+ (v1.05) by first resaving the WAV files in one of the following applications.

- ZOOM HandyShare (Windows/Mac)
- GarageBand (Mac)
- iTunes (Windows) / Music (Mac)
- Audacity (Windows/Mac)

### Installing HandyShare

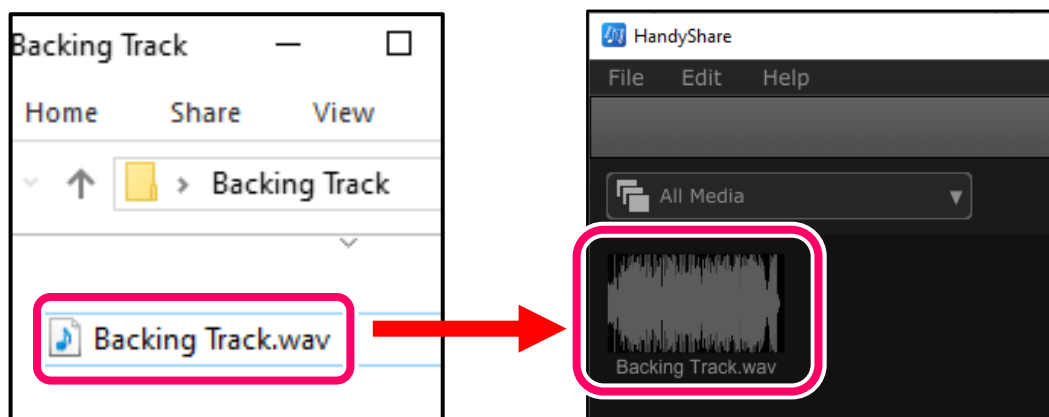

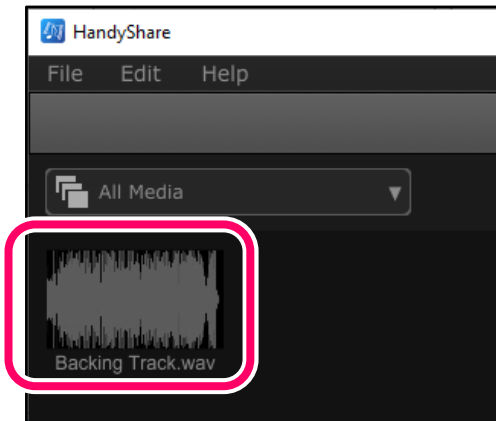
### Importing WAV files


Drag and drop WAV Files into HandyShare to import them.

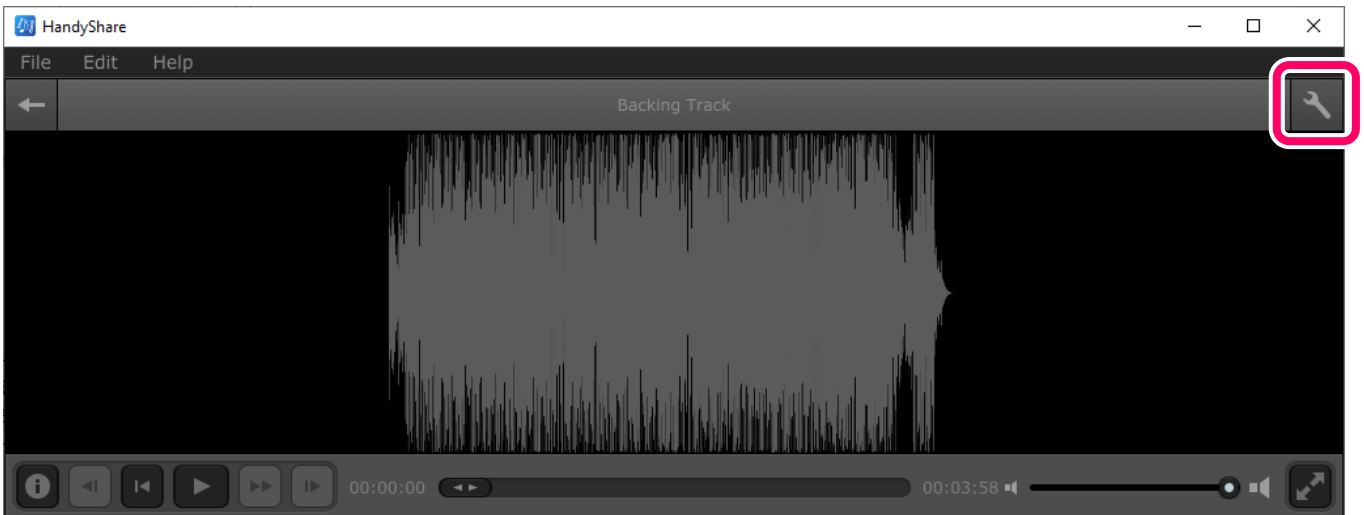



# Saving WAV files

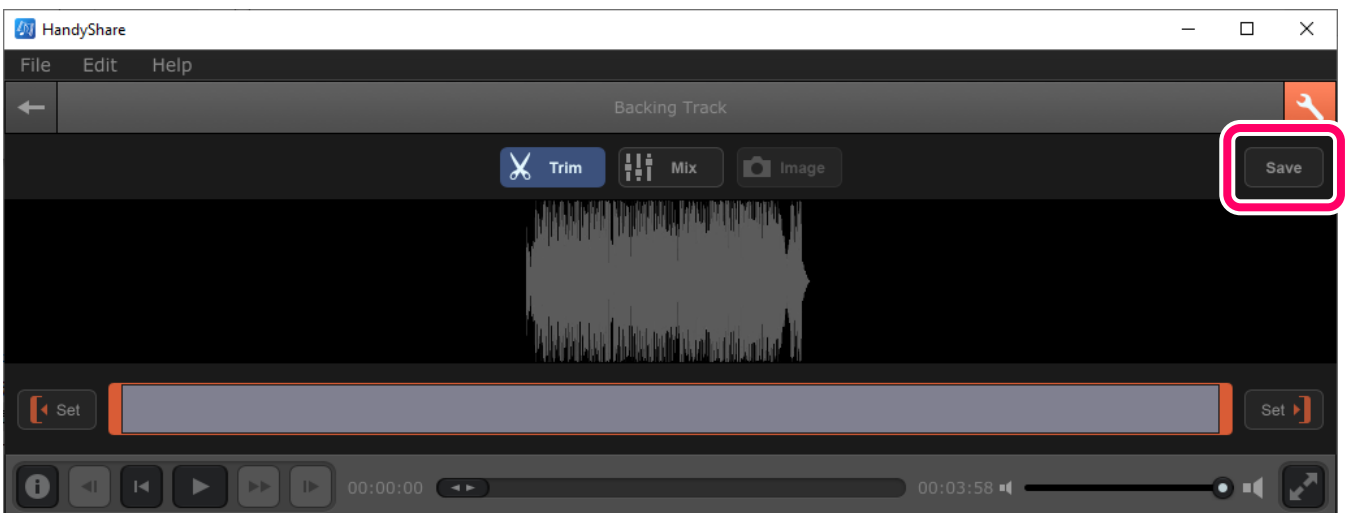
1. Double-click an imported WAV file.



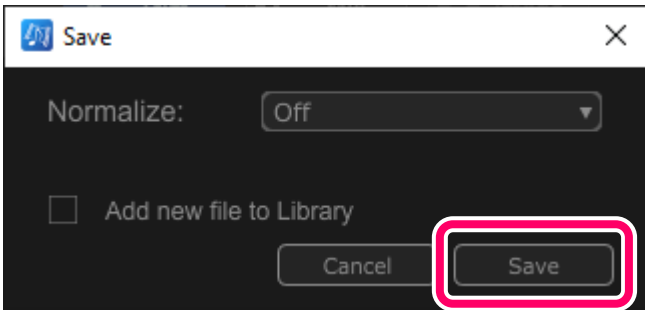
2. Click the  (function settings) button.



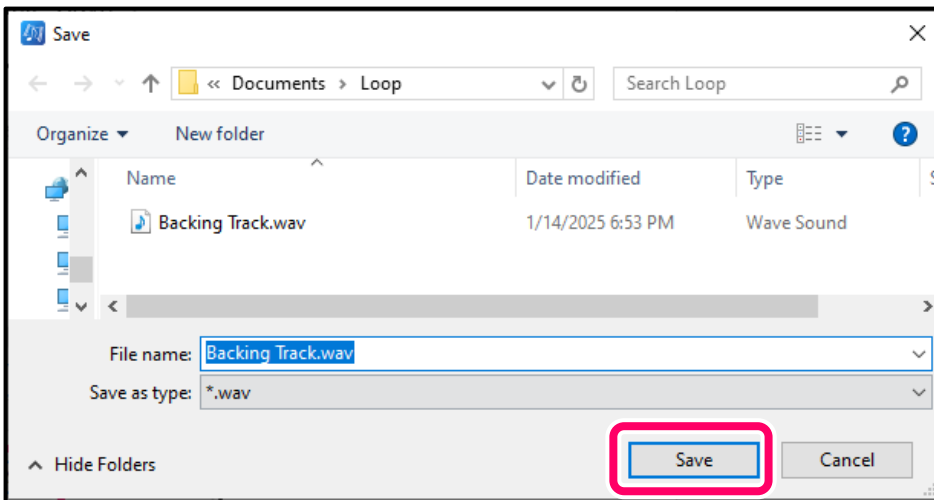
3. Click the  (save) button.
