Functions added in Version 1.1

Adjusting the USB output level in audio interface mode

The individual track levels output to the computer, smartphone or tablet can be adjusted.

1. Press (Operation button 1) on the Home Screen.

This opens the Menu Screen.



2. Use (operation button 2) and (operation button 3) to select "USB Audio Interface", and press

(operation button 4) to confirm.



3. Use (operation button 2) and (operation button 3) to select "Send Level", and press (operation button 4) to confirm.



4. Use (operation button 2) and (operation button 3) to select the track to set, and press (operation button 4) to confirm.



5. Use (operation button 2) and (operation button 3) to set the parameter value, and press (operation button 4) to confirm.

This parameter can be set to "Mute" or from -40 to +40 dB.



NOTE

- These settings are enabled when USB audio is set to "Multi Track".
- The MASTER track is output by USB with its post-fader level.

Applying internal effects to the SUB-MIX / MIX MINUS

Reverb and other internal effects can also be applied to the SUB-MIX and MIX MINUS.

1. Press (Operation button 1) on the Home Screen.

This opens the Menu Screen.




2. Use (operation button 2) and (operation button 3) to select "Mixer", and press (operation button 4) to confirm.





3. Use (operation button 2) and (operation button 3) to select "Effect Return", and press (operation button 4) to confirm.



4. Use (operation button 2) and (operation button 3) to select "Sub-Mix" or "Mix Minus", and press (operation button 4) to confirm.








NOTE

- Al Noise Reduction cannot be used with these.
- When using an effect with MIX MINUS, set the effect send level for channel 7 (USB 1–2) to zero. Mix minus is not applied to the effect sound.
